### Primary Ages 6-7

No previous ballet training is necessary. An audition is not required for admission in the Primary class.

Uniform: light blue leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers  
boys: white tee shirt, black shorts or tights, white socks, and black ballet slippers.

Two days per week are required.

Three days per week are required.

Uniform: red leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers.

### Level 3

Four days per week are required.

Uniform: lavender leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers.

Four days per week are required.

## SCHOOL POLICIES

Uniform requirements must be followed. Necklaces, bracelets, skirts, tutus and leg warmers are not permitted in class. Skirts attached or unattached to leotards are not acceptable.

All children must have their hair neatly pulled back for class. Girls should wear their hair in a bun if it's long enough.

Please call the school if you plan to be absent from class. Make-up classes can be arranged by appointment for missed classes.

It is the parents' and caregivers' responsibility to see that all children clean up any snacks and behave appropriately at all times.

Please do not leave your valuables unattended. The school is not responsible for lost articles.

Students in levels 1 and higher should attend all of their classes. We strongly recommend that students attend additional classes one level lower than their assigned level to strengthen their technique.

Students are expected to arrive on time for class. If a student is late, they should wait at the door of the studio until the teacher invites them into class.
